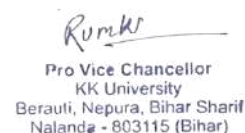

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1. About the University

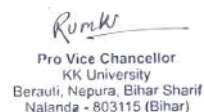
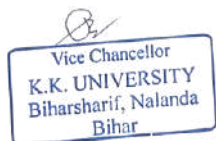
The K. K. University (KKU), Nalanda established under the Bihar Private Universities Act 2013 and passed by the Cabinet of Government of Bihar in its meeting held on May 16, 2017 has been notified vide 15/M 1-38/2014-1147 dt. June 8, 2017. It aims to offer quality higher education and focuses on modern teaching methodologies while fostering an environment conducive to research, innovation, and holistic development. Located in the historically significant district of Nalanda, known for its ancient educational heritage, K.K. University is positioned to contribute to both regional and national academic growth.

The Samajik Kalyan Sanstha as its sponsor aims at providing quality education in the fields of sciences, humanities & social sciences, paramedical, engineering, commerce and management, pharmacy, etc. by establishing appropriate infrastructure suitable to the spread of higher education (HE), vocational education & training (VET), and industry specific employment oriented programs for the development of trained manpower at various levels enabling overall growth of Bihar ,and also, help India establish global linkages as supplier of trained human resources across the world.

2. University at a Glance

K.K. University stands as a premier institution sprawling over a 24-acre campus with a built-up area that accommodates 112 classrooms and 70 teaching labs, maintaining a commendable computer-student ratio of 1:10 with 542 terminals. The university's robust sports infrastructure includes facilities for cricket, football, volleyball, kabaddi, kho-kho, athletics, basketball, and various indoor games. Its central library spans 24,720 square feet and boasts a collection of 13,692 books and 84 journals, supplemented by numerous e-journal databases. With 1,633 students enrolled for the academic year 2022-23, the university maintains a student-teacher ratio of 1:20, supported by 244 teaching staff and 112 non-teaching staff. The academic structure encompasses 9 departments offering a total of 55 programs: 22 undergraduate, 20 postgraduate, 6 diploma, and 7 Ph.D. programs, ensuring a comprehensive educational experience. Expanding further, K.K. University also prides itself on its state-of-the-art facilities and infrastructure. The campus includes spacious lecture halls, modern laboratories, and a well-equipped library to support academic pursuits. A commitment to best practices, sustainability, and a robust research culture underscores its dedication to producing well-rounded, future-ready graduates. K.K. University's holistic approach to education is designed to foster well-rounded individuals who are not only proficient in their chosen fields but also equipped to contribute meaningfully to society.

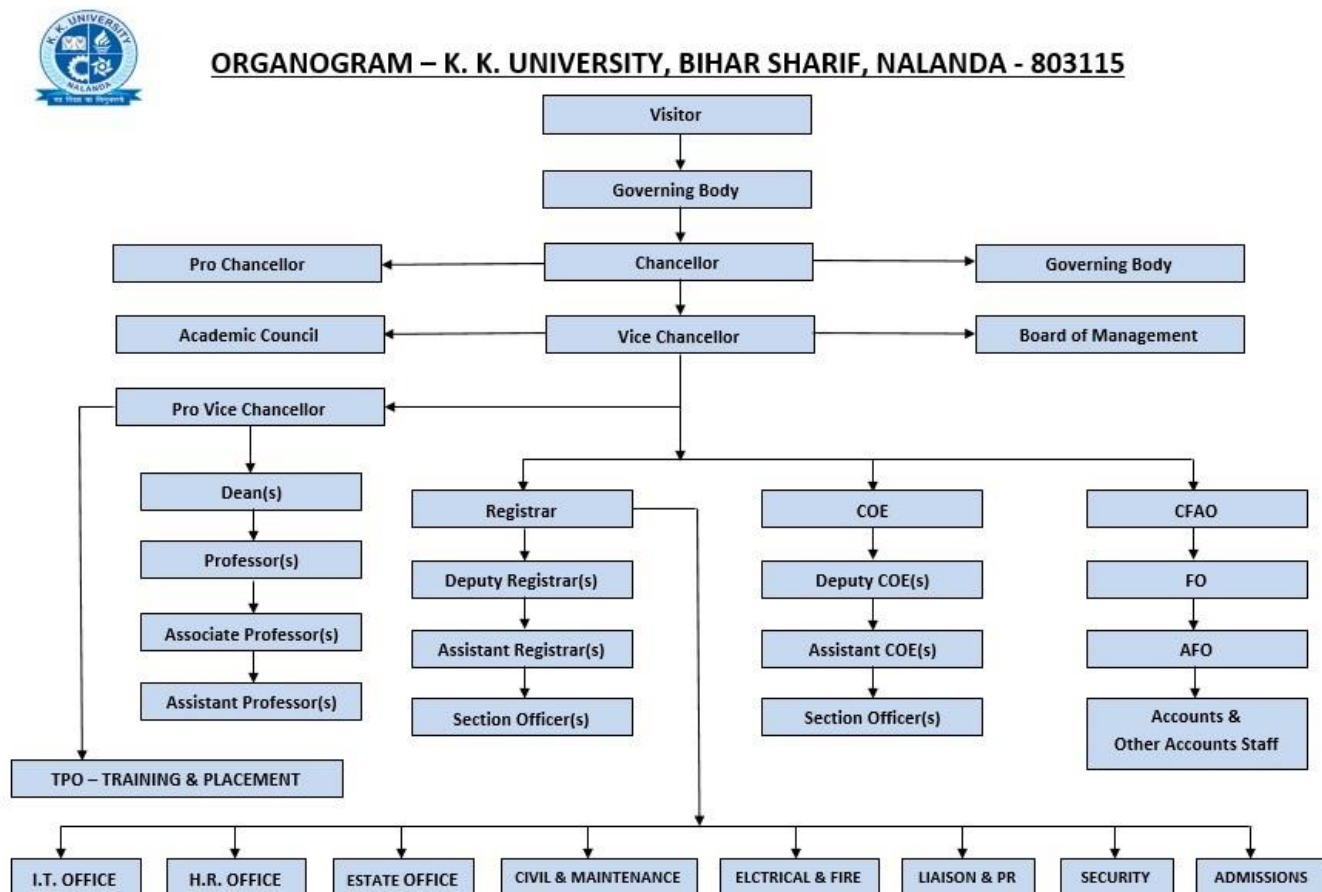

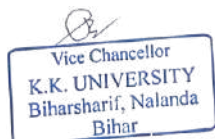

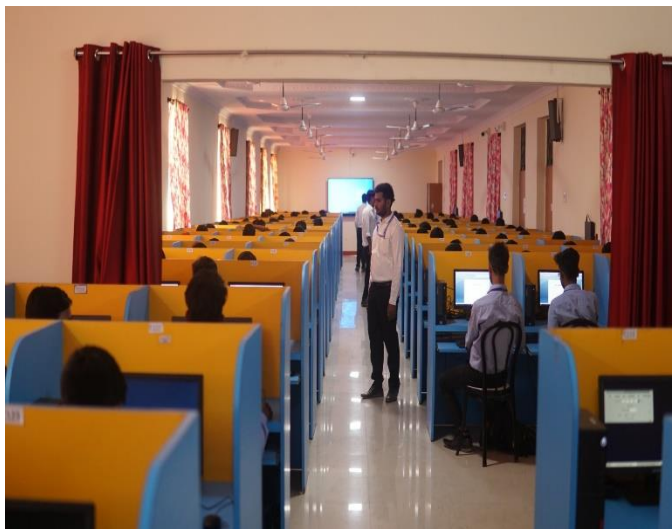
8. University Facilities

11. Examination Schedule

The University follows a structured Examination Schedule designed to ensure timely assessments and promote academic progress across all programs. The examination system includes mid-term exams, end-term exams, practical exams, and continuous assessments based on the course structure. Operating on a semester-based system, the academic year is divided into odd (July-December) and even (January-June) semesters. Mid-term exams occur mid-semester, helping students gauge their understanding, while end-term exams take place at the semester's end, covering the full syllabus. Practical exams, internal assessments, and supplementary/backlog exams are conducted as required. The Examination Department issues timetables and notifications in advance, and results are declared a few weeks post-exams, ensuring a smooth academic process.

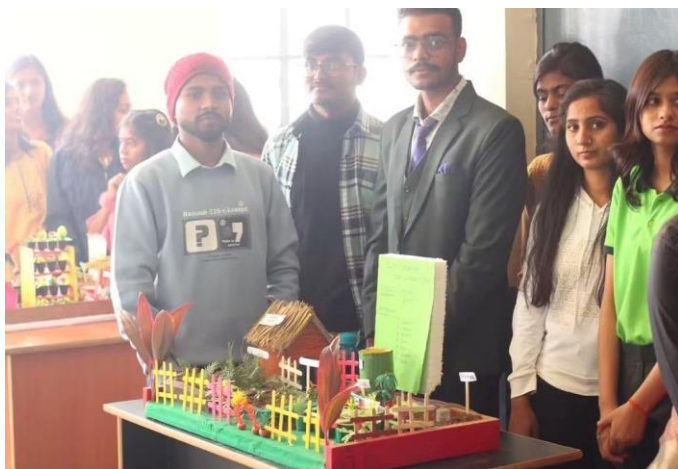

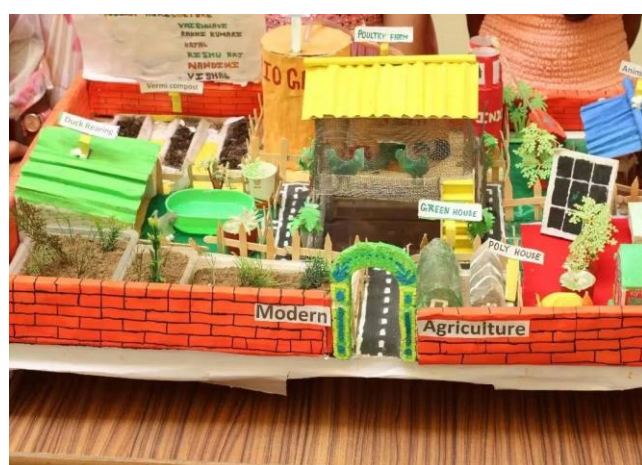

Training and Placement Department responsibility is to integrate industry and academia and create a platform to ensure that the students at K K UNIVERSITY, BIHARSHARIF are having level playing field when it comes to various interventions and opportunities. It brings along innovation in skill development and employability amongst our students. Initiatives like providing Career Counselling, need based education and industry relevant curriculum and soft skills developments. It has the task to arrange and organise campus interviews, Job fair, Industry Internship opportunity, and industrial visits for students. Training and Placement department initiate continuous interaction with industry, sharing industry experiences, and understanding the needs of corporate world. The quality of our infrastructure, the teaching and learning methods ensures overall development of the students. We concentrate on the development of students and preparing them to become entrepreneur or to get into leadership positions in a rapidly transforming and challenging work environment. Training and Placement department also networks with the institution's alumni for creating more career opportunities.

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Placement Policy & Guidelines:

The role of the Training and Placement Cell is of a facilitator and counsellor for placement related activities. Training and Placement Cell provides assistance to all the registered students as per the norms provided here. As an essential part of placement, we also provide training in soft and communication skills, aptitude training to all undergraduate final year students. Trainings are to be conducted by college faculty as well as industry specialist. The emphasis is to provide a learning environment in which all students are challenged to develop their intellectual, practical, and social skills in a holistic way focusing on leadership, socially responsible behaviour and lifelong learning. The objective is to make our student a perfect industry-fit and enhance their confidence, and also to make them well-aware of the fact that acquiring the right, industry-relevant skills gives them a better chance to compete for the job. In the upcoming time, we will also going to start a program/workshop with entrepreneurship skills for the career enhancement of the students. We organized ample number of sessions for career counselling of students with the perspective of nurturing them for respective career goals and give directions to it.

Eligibility Criterion for the students :

- a. Student should clear all the papers of each and every semester.
- b. Student should not have any backlog subjects.
- c. Student should secure a minimum of 50% score in internal marks.
- d. All the students eligible for placements shall register with the Training & Placement office (TPO) at the end of the 4th semester as per the Performa provide by T&P Department.
- e. Student with indiscipline case(s) will be disqualified from campus placement process.
- f. Students must attend all the training programs conducted by the institute.
- g. In case of job fair , students should attend as per the instruction of TPO.

Students Guidelines for placement:

- f. Student rejecting an internship offered through Placement Cell is required to inform (in writing through faculty mentor) to the Placement Office. Internships which may lead to a job will also be considered as placement in that company.
- g. Students are given choice to choose the company for placement based on their specialization in subject.
- h. Students should be ready to attend any screening programme conducted by placement cell

on the request of companies. Shortlisted students list only will be forwarded to companies.

- i. Dress code - Students must be formally dressed whenever they participate in any sort of interaction with a company. Minimum formal clothes for men includes formal shirt and trousers with tie, and leather shoes. Minimum formal clothes for women include either a pair of Salwar-Kameez (no binge) or formal shirt and trousers with neck tie.
- j. student who applies and gets selected or shortlisted is bound to go through the entire selection process unless rejected mid way by the companies.
- k. Placement season is an ongoing process which starts from the start of session and may go up to end of the session till the students are placed in various organizations.
- l. Placement committee cannot/will not personally recommend to HR of any company for a job offer or placement. It fully lies on the capability of students to crack the selection process.
- m. Once the students are placed in a company, they have to submit the photocopy of the offer letter with the placement officer for future reference.
- n. Students must keep their Identity Card with them at the time of PPT/Test/Group Discussion/Interviews, and produce the same when demanded by visiting team or TPC staff or their representatives. Candidates must also always carry 4 copies of their resume and 2 passport size photographs for the GD/Interview of a company.
- o. Students should maintain discipline and decorum in every activity during the placement process.
- p. Under no circumstances should a student negotiate with a company executive about CTC offered during the course of the selection process. Any student violating this norm will be liable to strict disciplinary action.
- q. Any issues to be discussed should be forwarded to the respective Student Placement Representative and it is his/her responsibility to take it up with Placements Cell.
- r. Students are expected to maintain decorum in all interactions with company officials such as PPT, written exam and so on. Students should reach for PPT/Test/Group Discussion/Interviews on time.
- s. Students are not allowed to use mobile phones in the vicinity of a company official and also are forbidden to carry the question paper out of the examination hall after the written exam.
- t. Student misbehaving in any manner with staff of Training and Placement Cell and student representatives will be debarred from Placement Session.

- u. Correct and verifiable information should be produced in the resume. Any student found violating this rule will be de-registered from the Placement Session.
- v. Student found adopting unfair means of any kind in placement procedure of any company the following policy will be adopted: The student will be debarred from participating in recruitment process of that company.

Placement General Process

Placement at our institute is student-driven. The placement committee will make a plan at the beginning of the year and design a placement brochure and disburse it to companies. It is also important for students to be in touch with the Placement Office, for consultation and any specific individual issues.

➤ **Placement Information:**

It is the prime responsibility of students to check all the updates related to Campus Recruitment Drives, its eligibility, dates, venue etc. available through their placement notice board or directly from placement department.

➤ **Eligibility**

All students need to ensure that they are meeting the eligibility criteria of the company as mentioned on the placement portal. All mark sheets are checked at the time of joining and if company finds that you have manipulated your marks / documents at the time of Campus Recruitment your job offer will be terminated and you name will be blacklisted forever.

➤ **Data**

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18. New Initiatives
