THE FIRST ORDINANCES

PREAMBLE

In furtherance of the objectives of the K. K. University established under Bihar Private University Act, 2013, [Bihar Act 20, 2013]the Board of Governors adopts the Statutes made thereunderthe First Ordinances vide section 32 of the Act to provide for the efficient, transparent and accountable governance and management of the University and any of the matters listed as under

PRELIMINARIES —

- These ordinances may be called K. K. University Ordinances, 2017
- They shall come into force on such date as the Governing Body may notify in the (1)(2)
- following domains.

Admission of students-(a)

In compliance with the norms set forth by the regulatory bodies like UGC. AICTE, NCTE, MCI, NCI, PCI and such agency/agencies established by the Central/State Government (Bihar) for regulation of education, the University will follow the following general criteria for selecting students for admission in various courses run by it.

9. Fees to be Charged for Various Programmes / Courses, Examinations, Degrees, Diplomas, Charters and Other Academic Distinctions of the University and revision of Fees

- (1) The Finance Committee (FC) of the University will determine, in consultation, with the Academic Council, the fee for the various programmes / courses of the University. The following aspects may be stipulated by the FC:
 - a) The admission fee to be paid at the time of registration of the student in a
 - b) Tuition fee, lab. fee, caution deposit, Hostel and Mess charges, and other charges.
 - c) Examination fee.
- (2) The FC may stipulate the method of payment of fee, and late fine in case there is delay in
- (3) The Finance Officer (FO) shall be responsible for collection of fees and sending reminders to students/parents for timely collection of fees.
- (4) All fees charged for each course / programme are subject to revision.
- (4) All lees only got to responsible to settle any disputes related to payment of fees.
 (5) The Registrar is responsible to settle any disputes related to payment of fees.
